QUESTIONS

- 1. Start your discussion by sharing what point(s) stuck out to you most in the service.
- 2. The Chief Apostle started the service by stating that every divine service is a profession. What do you profess in a divine service? (think through the different liturgical elements)
- 3. What is the difference between the hope we have in Christ and dreams and wishes?
- 4. How can we be purified from sin? Walk through the steps of repentance and discuss how they can be purifying.
- 5. Why is humility such an important aspect of repentance and purification?
- 6. How would you describe a person who is true and sincere? How do they act and speak?
 - a. Consider the last time you spoke about someone a little differently than you would to their face... Or posted something online that you would never say in person... Or tried to hide what you were looking at on the internet?
 - b. Why is it difficult to be a true and sincere person?
- 7. How can we purify our love towards God and our neighbor?

9.	What aspect of purification is Peter an example of? What	
	did he have to change to be one with Christ?	
10.	What is the danger of putting people into groups?

11.	Discuss these various actions that the Chief Apostle said were a "waste of time":
